MINUTES OF THE MEETING:**TUESDAY 15 MAY 2018:****Welcome and coffee, goal of the 34th project meeting & agenda:**

After welcoming all participants, Durk van Wieren thanked Lene Munk Larsen, Iben Vibe Ostergaard and Henrik Gräs for their hospitality. The goals of the 4th project meeting and the content of the agenda were discussed (no changes/additions required). The used PowerPoint presentation can be found in the annexes to these minutes.

Danish Care a la Carte (Competence Assessment, Student Background, Missing Document & Language Difficulties):

Ms. Helene Svejgård Nielsen held a presentation about the Danish system for 'Recognition of previous acquired competences'. Starting with a competence assessment (which we visited during our school tour). A 'tailor made' education program is developed and executed based on the outcomes of the assessment.

Guided tour at SOSU Fyn:

A guided tour at the SOSU Fyn school was held, including a visit at the assessment of previous acquired competences.

Minutes of the 3rd project meeting (5 & 6 February 2018, Germany):

The minutes of the previous meeting were (shortly) discussed. No changes required.

Evaluation of the 3rd project meeting (5 & 6 February 2018, Germany):

The results of the online survey regarding the previous meeting were discussed. Conclusions: all participants were (very) satisfied on all subjects.

Interim report:

In order to inform the Dutch Erasmus+ National Agency, an interim/progress report had to be sent in before May 1st. Durk van Wieren wrote this report (see as annex) and has sent this in on 26 April. Outcomes will be discussed during the next Project meeting.

Danish health care education system:

Iben Brøndum has held a presentation and most 'remarkable' items were discussed.

Situation of refugees in Denmark:

Ms. Aija Polvsen and Mr. Henrik Berggren Jensen held a presentation about 'Integration net' (www.integrationsnet.dk). 4 weeks after arrival in Denmark, a process to help refugees (mainly Syrian and Somali) to prepare for work. Problem is that lots of refugees (mainly the women) didn't have a proper education. Which means that nothing can be recognized. Next to that many refugees suffer with PTSD. In order to stimulate the target group to actively participate in this process, the social welfare benefits are really low. Employers can earn a subsidy to create (learning) jobs. Once participating in this process; a lot of guidance is organised (mainly to promote the positive chances). In order to measure progress, a competence scheme is evaluated on a regular basis. Integration net is an independent organisation and is financed by the local communities (by sending invoices). Profit is sent to foreign refugee camps.

Guided tour at 'Svanedammens plejecenter':

Svanedammens plejecenter is a care center/home for elderly people. Two former refugees (from Sri-Lanka and Somalia) gave the tour and explained about the care they give to their guests. After the tour a meeting was held with these two ladies to discuss their experiences. Main conclusions:



- Language education is very important!
- Give newcomers chances;
- Please be patient. The integration process is very complicated and hard;
- A buddy is very helpful;
- Show (also) interest for the cultural background of the newcomers.
- Please skip prejudices. Integration from another culture is really hard and difficult;

Template for the analysis:

After some discussions it was decided to analyse the Competence assessment (recognition of previously gained competences) + tailor made education program incl. IGU). Analysis of this 'pearl' can be found as an annex.

Impact:

After some discussion it was decided that all partners will look back at the analysed 'pearls/best practices' and see which elements they will try to incorporate in their organisation. The Aventus delegation already decided to bring the discussed assessment procedure into their organisation.

WEDNESDAY, 16 MAY 2018:

Welcome and agenda for the day:

All participants were again welcomed by Durk van Wieren

Template for the analysis:

Further discussed and finalized.

Dissemination:

Durk showed a few proposals for the IFCALC project logo. The one used in the heading of this document was unanimously chosen and will be used in further communication.

Website is under progress. Communication with developing students was hard. Durk will inform all partners as soon the concept website is available.

It was asked to share all possible information about this project on social media and (if possible) websites and to gather evidence (print screens). These will be needed for the interim and final report of this project.

Press release and presentation to management:

The project, this 4th meeting and the outcomes were presented to Mrs. Charlotte Sigurdsson (Deputy Head Master). A short discussion occurred about the continuation of the project outcomes. Since the person responsible for press releases was called away, it was agreed that the attendants of SOSY Fyn would arrange a press release after the meeting.

End of 4th project meeting:

After thanking the hosts (again) for their great hospitality and good organisation, the meeting was closed at around 11:15 hour and all participant travelled home.
